## The new edition from October 17<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.

The third edition of **Milano Jewelry Week** is scheduled from **October 17<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023**, with a packed schedule of events that will populate the city along with international brands and artists.

Sponsored by **CNA Federmoda**, the **Milano Jewelry Week** celebrates the **history, tradition** and **innovation** of the fascinating world of international **jewelry**: the event represents the excellence of the industry and **Excellence Magazine is the official media partner** of this edition.

More than **100 events** will take place this year, expected **350 exhibitors** from **40 countries** around the world who will present more than **5,000 pieces of jewelry** inside historic palaces, schools, ateliers, showrooms, boutiques and goldsmith workshops in the city of Milan.
